## Accelerating the wound healing process


Odin had a very large caudal Mast cell tumor removed from his left hock. An anterior releasing incision was made to close the surgical excision.

After 20 days of regular bandage changes and immobilization, the incision site still had very little improvement.

Dr. Aron applied the liquid rhPDGF-BB from GEM Vet to a collagen membrane and applied it to the wound site, bandaging as before. The rate of healing accelerated to nearly complete closure within a few weeks.
